

# Do Ink Green Screen App Tutorial

## Create a Storyboard

1. Decide on a topic for the video.
2. Look at the photos and videos that are currently in the Camera Roll of the iPad.
3. Create a storyboard for a video which is no longer than 1 minute.

## Collect the Media

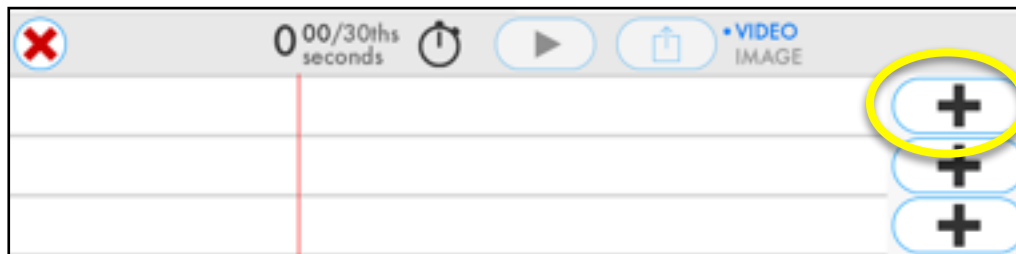
1. Create any needed photos and video on the Camera Roll by taking photos or videos using the iPad's camera.
2. Add any needed photos or videos to the Camera Roll by saving (importing) them from the Internet or another app.

## Record the Green Screen Video

1. Frame the the narrator so that they are taking up the appropriate amount of space without blocking where the media will be displayed in the final video.
2. Use the Camera in the iPad to record the video of the narrator speaking in front of a Green Screen (do not use the camera inside of the Do Ink Green Screen app).

## Add Green Screen Track 1

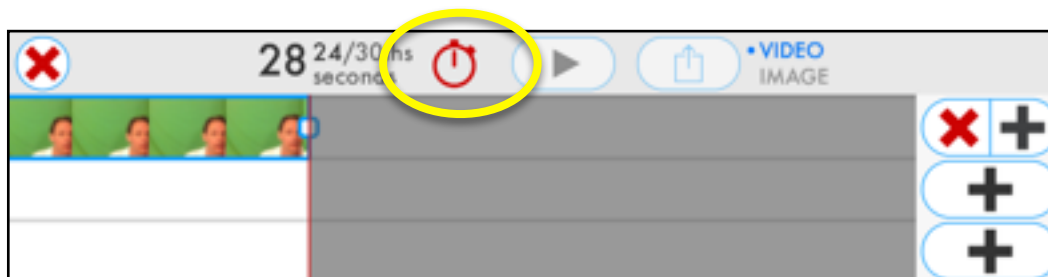
1. Open the Do Ink Green Screen app.
2. Tap the + (top right).
3. Tap the + for Track 1.



4. Tap Video.
5. Tap Videos.
6. Find the Green Screen Video of the Narrator.
7. Tap the Video
8. Tap Use.
9. Adjust the Chroma Filter Wheel and Sensitivity until the background disappears.

## Set an End Point for the Video

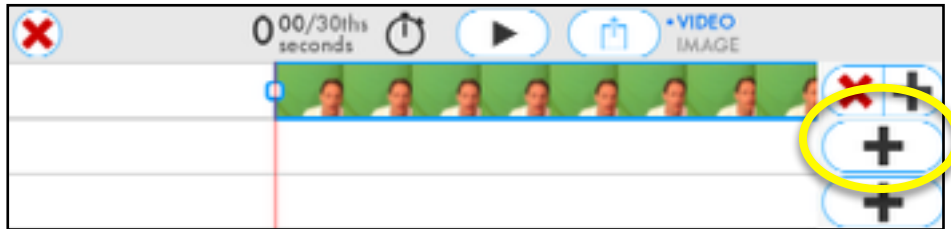
1. Slide Track 1 to the end of the video
2. Tap the Stop Watch button (turns red)



## Do Ink Green Screen App Tutorial

### Add a Video to Track 2

1. Slide the track to where the shot will begin.
2. Tap + on Track 2.



3. Tap Video.
4. Tap Videos
5. Tap the Video.
6. Tap Use.

### Add an Image to Track 2

1. Slide the track to where the shot will begin.
2. Tap + on Track 2.
3. Tap Image.
4. Tap Camera Roll.
5. Tap the Image.

### Play the Final Video

1. Slide the tracks to 0 seconds.
2. Tap the Play button.
