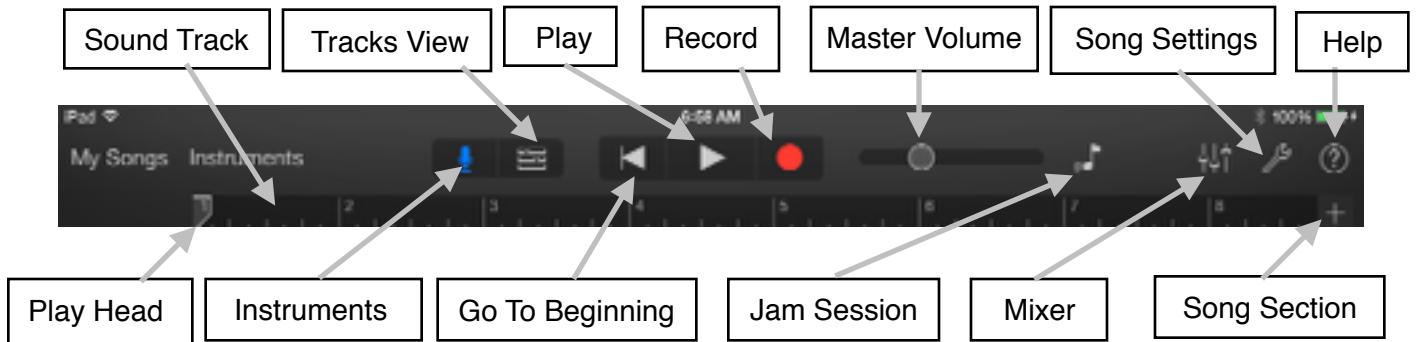


GarageBand for iOS 7 Interview

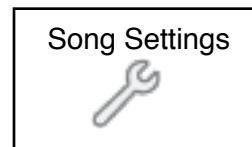


Add a Song (Interview)

1. Tap the Plus button (top left)
2. Swipe to the Audio Recorder (Microphone), if needed
3. Tap the Microphone

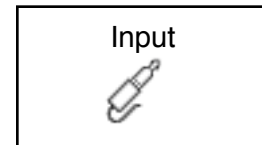
Turn Metronome and Count-in Off for a Song

1. Tap the Song Settings button
2. Tap the Metronome slider (turns it off)
3. Tap the Count-in slider (turns it off)
4. Tap anywhere outside the settings window



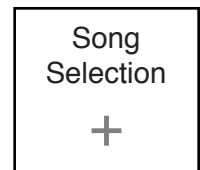
Reduce Background Microphone Noise

1. Tap the Input button (near top left)
2. Tap the Noise Gate slider (turns it blue which is on)
3. Drag slider about halfway
4. Tap anywhere outside the settings window



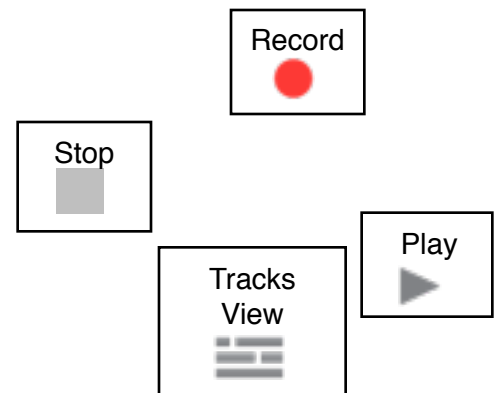
Set the Length of Tracks to Automatic (Unlimited)

1. Tap the Song Section button (end of the Sound Track)
2. Tap Section A
3. Tap the Automatic Switch (turns it blue which is on)
4. Tap anywhere outside the settings window

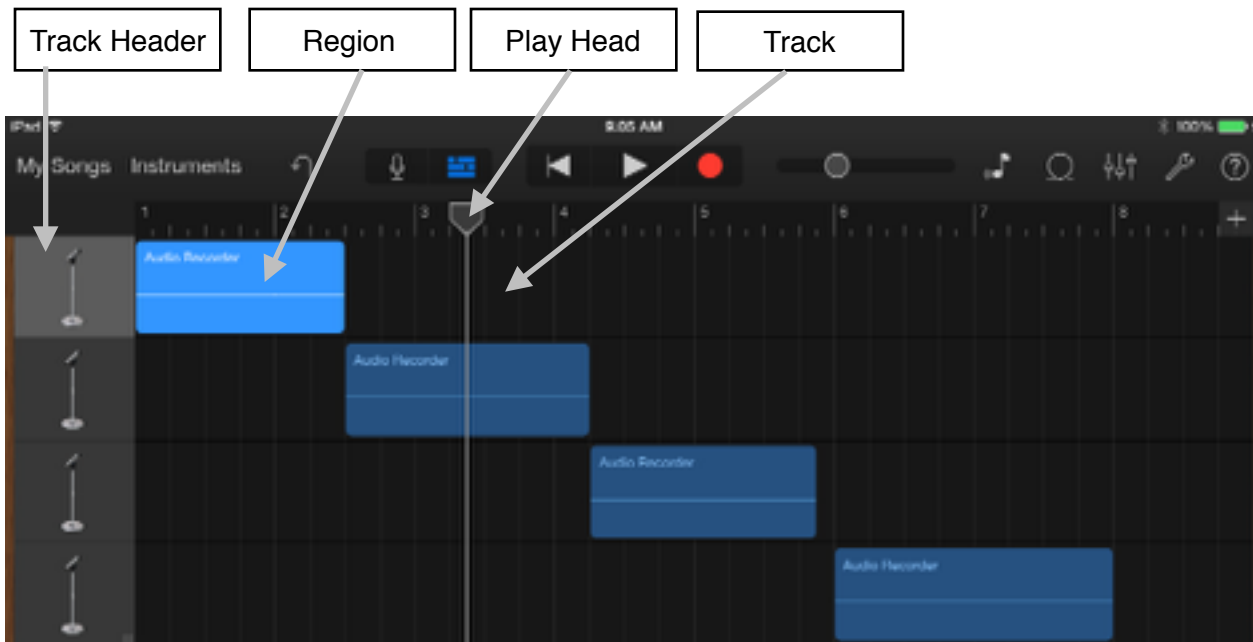


Record the Introduction Audio for the Track 1

1. Tap the Record button
2. Interviewer begins speaking the dialogue for the Introduction
3. Tap the Stop button
4. Tap the Play button to review the recording
5. Tap the Stop button
6. Tap the Tracks View button (saves the audio)

Mute the Introduction Track

1. Open the Tracks Controls by dragging the Track Header to the right
2. Tap the Mute icon for the track (turns blue)



Create the Question Audio for Track 2

1. Tap the + button (bottom left)
2. Tap the Microphone
3. Tap the Record button
4. Interviewer begins speaking the dialogue for the Question
5. Tap the Stop button
6. Tap the Play button to review the recording
7. Tap the Stop button
8. Tap the Tracks View icon (saves the audio)

Mute the Question Track

1. Tap the Mute icon for the track (turns blue)

Create the First Interviewee Audio Track 3

1. Tap the + button (bottom left)
2. Tap the Record button
3. Interviewee begins speaking the dialogue for the Question
4. Tap the Stop button
5. Drag the Play Head to the end of the current recording
6. Tap the Record button
7. Interviewer begins speaking the dialogue for the Followup Question
8. Interviewee answers the Followup Question
9. Tap the Stop button
10. Tap the Play button

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11. Tap the Stop button
12. Tap the Tracks View icon (saves the audio to the current track)

Mute the First Interviewee Audio Track

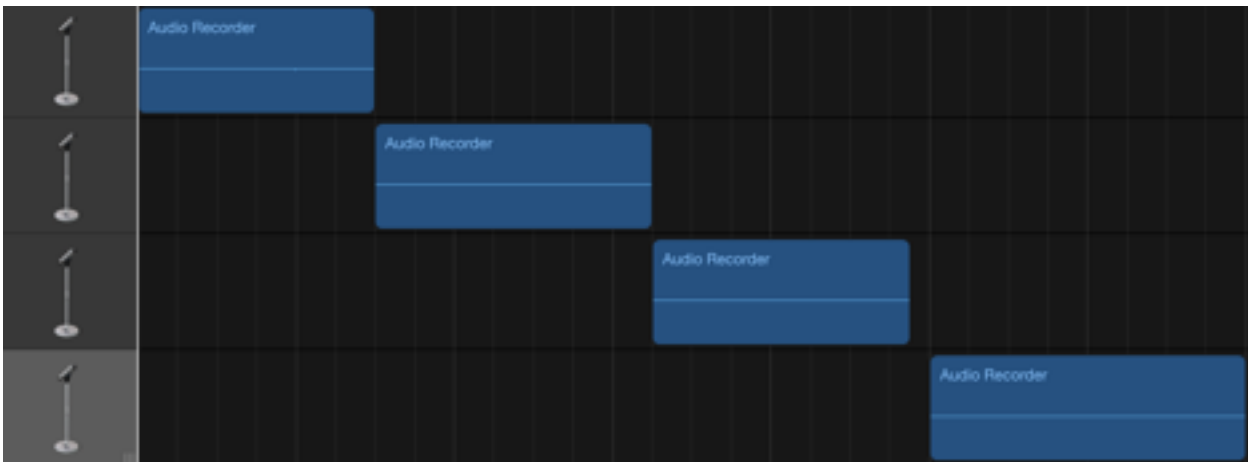
1. Tap the Mute icon for the track (turns blue)

Create Additional Interviewee Audio Tracks

1. Follow the steps used to create the First Interviewee Track 3

Position Regions for the Completed Audio Interview

1. Tap mute icons for all tracks to Un-mute them
2. Close the Tracks Controls by dragging to the Track Header to the left
3. Pinch an empty area below all the tracks to compress the size of the Sound Track
4. Drag the audio region for Track 2 to the right so that its beginning is below the end of the the audio region for Track 1
5. Drag the audio region for Track 3 to the right so that its beginning is below the end of the the audio region for Track 2
6. Drag all other audio regions so their beginnings line up with the end of the track above them



Test the Complete Audio Interview

1. Tap the Go To Beginning button
2. Tap the Tap the Play button
3. Make adjustments or edits to regions and tracks as needed



Export to SoundCloud

1. Tap My Songs (top left)
2. Tap Select (top right)
3. Tap the Song (Interview)
4. Tap the Action button (top left)
5. Tap SoundCloud
6. Tap Private
7. Tap Share (top right)
