

# HTML - Basic Code

**Bold Text** (used to display text in bold)

**Tags:** Both the opening tag `<b>` and the closing tag `</b>` are required

**Example:** `<b>Tree</b>`

**Result:** Tree

**Color Text** (used to display text in a specific color)

**Tags:** Both the opening tag `<font color = "??????">` and the closing tag `</font>` are required.

**Example:** `<font color = "#9933ff">Grapes </font>`

**Result:** Grapes

**Comments:** There are 216 hexadecimal numbers used to format text in various colors. Sixteen specific names for colors can be used instead of a hexadecimal color.

**Italicized Text** (used to display text in italics format):

**Tags:** Both the opening tag `<i>` and the closing tag `</i>` are required

**Example:** `<i> Special </i>`

**Result:** *Special*

**Font Size** (used to display text in a specific size)

**Tags:** Both the opening tag `<font size= ?>` and the closing tag `</font>` are required

**Example:** `<font size= 5> Big </font>`

**Result:** Big

**Comments:** There are seven basic font sizes. The largest font is size 7, standard size is 3 and the smallest size font is 1.

**Break** (used to create a new line for text or spacing)

**Tags:** Only the tag `<br>` is required. No closing tag is needed.

**Example:** One `<br>` Two

**Result:** One

Two

**Comments:** Multiple `<br>` tags can be used to create multiple line breaks.

**Hyperlink** (used to create a link to a web site on the Internet)

**Tags:** Both the opening tag `<a href="http://?????????">` and the closing tag `</a>` are required. **Example:** `<a href="http://www.gmu.edu">George Mason University</a>`

**Result:** [George Mason University](http://www.gmu.edu)

**Image** (used to add an image to a web page). Image file must be uploaded

**Tags:** ``

**Example:** ``

**Result:**



**Comments:** Only specific types of image files can be displayed. The three major image file types are JPEG (.jpg), GIF (.gif) and PNG (.png).
