

Making a Flipbook

THINK OF A STORY

1. Choose one or two of the characters listed below:

Fish	Car	Flower	Horse
Bird	Boat	Tree	Bicycle
Duck	Plane	Dog	Chair

2. Choose a storyline that includes one or two of the actions list below:

Jumping	Appearing	Shrinking
Flying	Disappearing	Morphing
Racing	Growing	Meeting

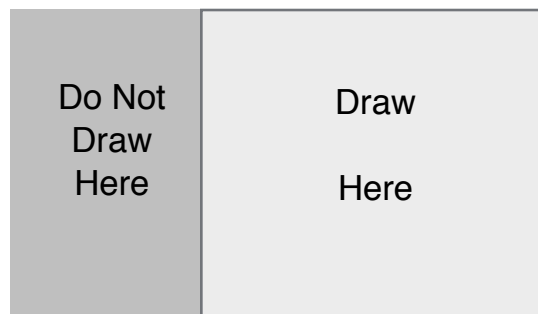
3. Decide on a beginning, middle, and end to the story.

CREATE A STORYBOARD

1. Create a storyboard with six shots. Put the number of each shot in the Number box. Enter the number 10 in the Frames box of each shot.
2. There should be no background (i.e. trees, sky, water). There should only be one or two characters.
3. The first shot should include the title of the flipbook and your group name.

CREATE THE FLIPBOOK

1. Use the storyboard you created above to draw the Frames (pictures)
2. Divide the six shots between group members.
3. Each group member draws on index cards the frames (pictures) needed for the shots they are assigned. Draw frames (pictures) on the right side of the card.



4. Collect the index cards from each group member and assemble all 60 frames (index cards) in the correct order they were in the storyboard.

VIEW THE FLIPBOOK

1. Flip the cards using the right side of the cards.
2. Create new cards or remove any cards if needed.
